






Breakdown by Category







Delegates breakdown




Breakdown by Speciality (Excluding industry)




Geographic breakdown


















How would you rate the Industry symposia - Thursday February 7th







How would you rate the Industry symposia - Friday February 8th




How would you rate the Industry symposia - Saturday February 9th






Grants: 38% benefited of the Grant Industry




